Sportsmanlike Conduct Policy

EFFECTIVE: 1-1-2001

In order to maintain and promote good sportsmanship at youth and adult activities, the Douglas-Coffee County Recreation Commission and Douglas-Coffee County Parks and Recreation Department requires all parents, coaches, and officials to read, agree to and sign the following policy:

All players, coaches, officials, parents, and spectators should represent themselves and the Douglas-Coffee Parks & Recreation Department with the upmost courteous sportsmanship at all times.

ANYONE who does not represent this sportsmanship at all times will be disciplined accordingly.

1. Youth Players will be suspended for one (1) game. After the first suspension, the player will be suspended for the entire season and the player will have to appear before the Douglas-Coffee County Recreation Commission before returning to playing another sport with the Douglas-Coffee County Parks & Recreation Department.
2. Adult Player will be suspended for two (2) games and will be fined \$20.00 before returning to play. After the first suspension, the player will be suspended for the entire season and fined \$30.00 and the player will have to appear before the Douglas-Coffee County Recreation Commission before returning to playing another sport with the Douglas-Coffee County Parks & Recreation Department.
3. Coaches and Officials will be suspended for two (2) games and will be fined \$20.00 before returning to play. After the first suspension, the coach/official will be suspended for the entire season and fined \$30.00 and the coach/official will have to appear before the Douglas-Coffee County Recreation Commission before returning to coaching/officiating with the Douglas-Coffee County Parks & Recreation Department.
4. Parents and spectators will be suspended from the facility for one (1) game and will be fined \$20.00 before returning to the facility. After the first suspension, the parent or spectator will be suspended from the facility for the entire season and fined \$30.00 and the parent/spectator will have to appear before the Douglas-Coffee County Recreation Commission before returning to any Douglas-Coffee County Parks and Recreation Facility.
